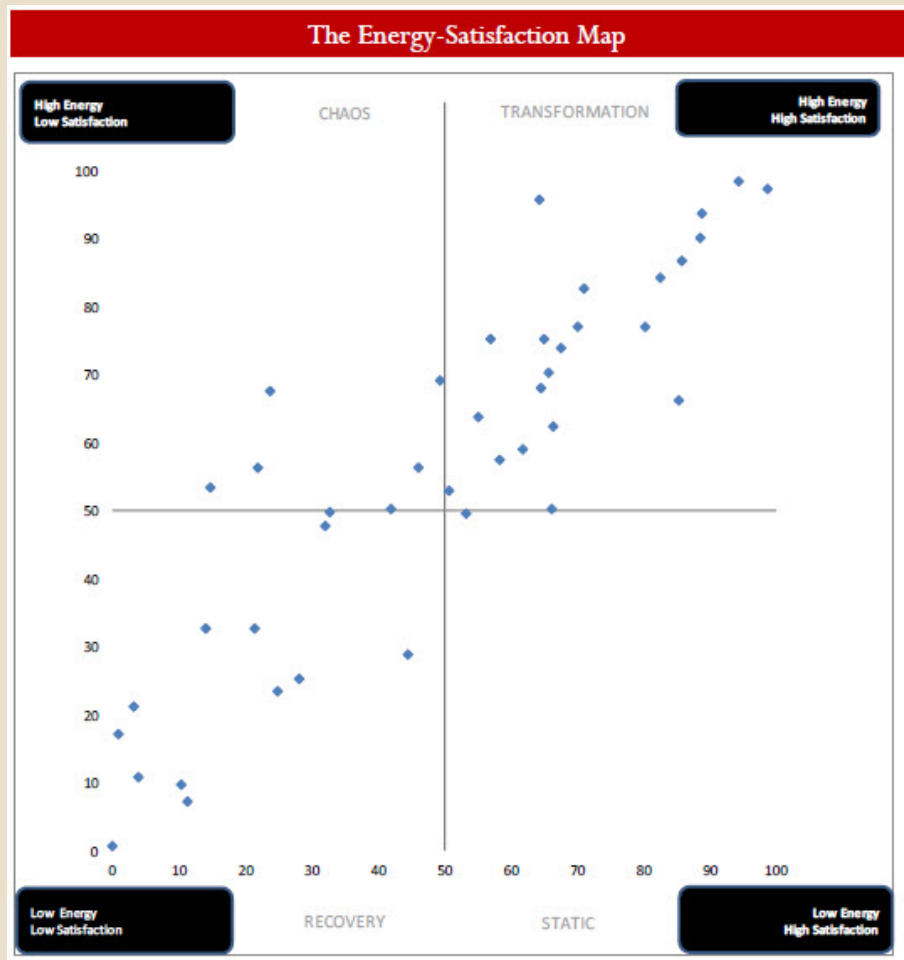


The Many Uses of a CAT

Our Presbytery partners with Holy Cow! Consulting to offer our congregations the Congregational Assessment Tool (CAT) for several reasons: 1) The Transformation Team has found the CAT to be a wonderful diagnostic tool to help congregational leadership to make informed decisions. 2) We've also discovered that it helps our team to discern how best to come alongside a congregation and to equip them toward transformation. 3) Looking at the results of the CAT on a macro level (all participating churches) helps our team understand how we might better serve the Presbytery.



The photo offers a snapshot of our Presbytery (as of 9/2017) in terms of a congregational energy level and satisfaction. Where is your congregation on the map? Are you in the upper right-hand quadrant? If so, you might consider applying for a Next Step Grant, or teaming up with the New Thing team to spin off another congregation or develop an additional worship service. Are you in the Chaos or Recovery/Reinvention quadrant? We've got Coaches that are willing to come alongside your leadership. Are you somewhere in the middle? Then you might consider having your leadership join us at The Well. Our objective as the Transformation Team is to challenge congregations in the Transformation quadrant to sustain the good work they are doing, while providing encouragement and tools to those in the other three quadrants as they move toward transformation.
